Weather wise right now here on the holiday island (4.30PM) we have an outside temperature of 28 degree's Celsius and the humidity on 63%. Wind direction is coming out of the East @ 13kms.

Okay, okay, so in our dreams. That's the conditions in Bali. Ours don't look so rosy. We're expecting a shower or two, a top of 13 degrees, low tide, messy onshore winds, but on the positive side, maybe a bit of swell.
